By working with the Province, non-profit organizations and private industry, we are able to work together to address the growing problem of homeless families. By taking over a building that was scheduled for demolition we were able to give shelter to homeless families during the winter months. This initiative was never done before. We all worked together to help people not only to find temporary shelter but also to find permanent residences across the City. The success of this program not only gave shelter but hope to many families during trying times. This can hopefully be used as a model of how to "give a hand up" across the Province and provide a permanent solution versus a "Band-Aid" approach to a growing problem.

Runaround Program

With the help of City Administration and community associations, we were able to offer a free pilot program for children that ran over the eight-week summer vacation. Children could show up their local community hall and play games and do activities under supervision. The hours are similar to school hours and the program provides a great environment for children to play with local kids. A stronger sense of community is formed when the children get to know each other and the parents meet their neighbours.

Charity Golf Tournament

One of the greatest pleasures of being an Alderman was the ability to gather the community around a good cause. Through support from people and local business, we were able to start hosting an annual Charity Golf Tournament in order to help those in need. I am very proud to say that we have donated over \$40,000 to worthy causes. For example, we were able to help a local boy (who had a rare form of blood cancer) and his family with their overwhelming medical expenses. He is happy and healthy thanks to everyone's support and best wishes.
